

In an e-mail to Universal®'s Adam Hartley on May 11, 2012,
UK Help Desk clarified the following:

**UK Help Desk confirms Small Emitter Opt-Out Scheme
does not apply to aviation**

Dear Adam,

Thank you for your email.

Article 27 of the ETS Directive relates to 'installations' only (i.e. stationary sources).

It does not apply to aircraft operators who are classified as 'small emitters'.

I am sorry if the consultation document has caused some confusion.
