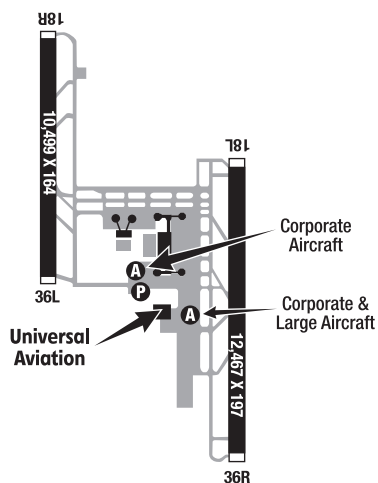

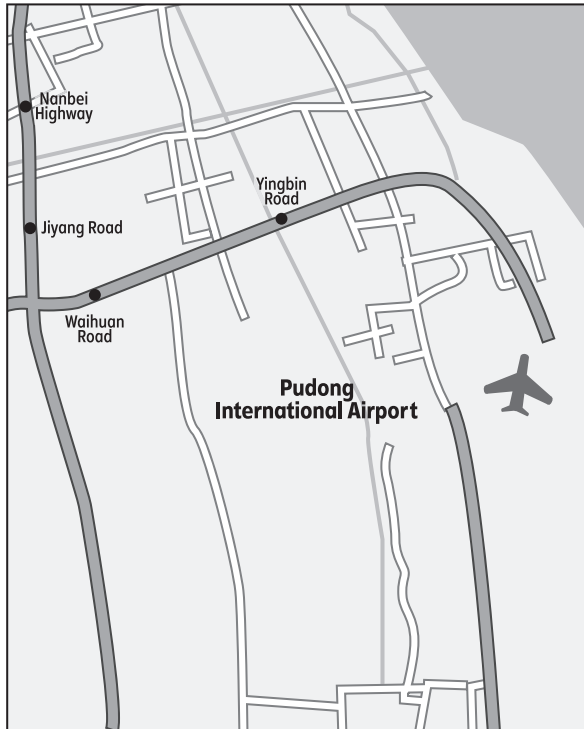

Directions to Shanghai Airport (ZSPD)

Shanghai Pudong International Airport (ZSPD) is located east of Shanghai city. Starting from JW Marriott Hotel Shanghai, travel south and drive onto the Nanbei Highway. In about 7.2km, you will reach Jiyang Road. After driving 3.5km on Jiyang Road, you will reach Waihuan Road. Head east and continue driving on the Waihuan Road. After 24km, you will reach Yingbin Road. Continue driving on Yingbin Road until it ends, where you will see Shanghai Pudong International Airport.
