Opening of Aircraft Operator Holding Account on Ireland's National Emission Trading Registry

This correspondence is issued further to your inclusion on the list published by Ireland's Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) in October 2011 for the free allocation of aviation allowances to aircraft operators, for whom the EPA submitted an application for free allocation to the European Commission.

This correspondence provides information on the opening of the required aircraft operator holding account (AOHA) on Ireland's National Emission Trading Registry which is held on the Union Registry. It is your responsibility to review the attached guidance documentation on how to open an aircraft operator holding account (AOHA) and provide the relevant information to the Registry Team as soon as possible so that we can proceed with opening your account on the Union Registry in 2012.
